

Summer Teacher Fellowship

Available to 5th – 12th grade Educators in North America
July 8 – July 10, 2015 in Los Angeles

The IWitness team is searching for educators who are passionate about teaching, interested in creating IWitness activities and other resources, and dedicated to impacting student learning. Designed for up to 10 teachers, this fellowship program will provide opportunities for participants to develop IWitness activities and other multimedia resources in a collegial and supportive environment. Participants will be provided with orientation, ongoing support throughout the duration of the program and will work with the IWitness development team to reach specific goals for content development.

Fellowship Description

- Program Dates are July 8 through July 10, 2015 at the USC Shoah Foundation office in Los Angeles.
- Travel, room and board expenses will be covered by the Institute at the rates set in University policy.
- Candidates will be chosen based on the following criteria:
 - Hold a current teaching position in upper primary to secondary school level.
 - Subject area expertise in the humanities, science, media studies and related areas
 - Demonstrated skills in curriculum development
 - Digital skills
 - Leadership experience among peers
 - Evidence of quality of work
- Fellows will be expected to create IWitness activities by the conclusion of the program.
